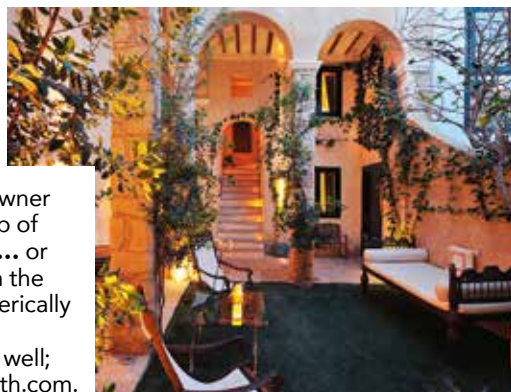


5 REASONS YOU'LL ADORE ANDALUSIA

The southernmost province of Spain, sun-drenched Andalusia combines the best of Europe's historic charm with the exotic glamour of its closest neighbour, Morocco. The walled hilltop town of Vejer de la Frontera is the prettiest of the Pueblos Blancos, or white villages. Its narrow, ancient streets are crowded with bars and authentic tapas restaurants and make a tranquil base to explore the region, which is packed with things to do - you can even take a ferry and visit Morocco's coastal city of Tangier for the day. ★



1 Have a sundowner on the rooftop of the **HOTEL V...** or a treatment in the spa, atmospherically located in the building's old well; mrandmrsmith.com.

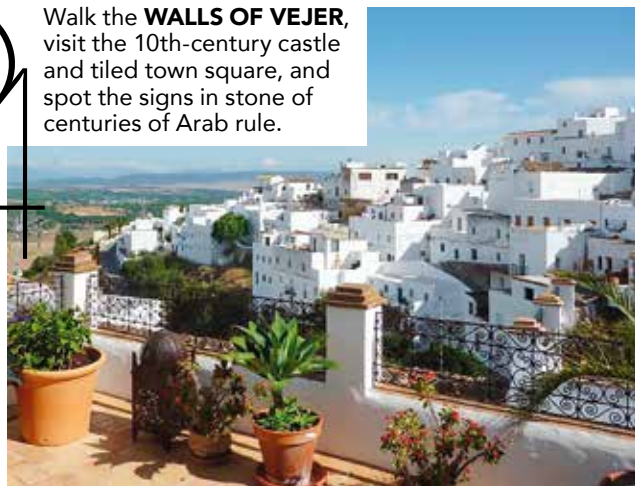


2 Visit Jerez for flamboyant flamenco, the famous dancing horses and sherry, which originated here. Try **TABANCO SAN PABLO**, an old-fashioned bar with great tapas; tabancosanpablo.es.

Soak up the atmosphere in **SEVILLE**, with its Moorish palaces, cathedrals and shady squares built for sipping sherry and watching the world go by.



3 Walk the **WALLS OF VEJER**, visit the 10th-century castle and tiled town square, and spot the signs in stone of centuries of Arab rule.



4 **EL JARDÍN DEL CALIFA**'s lantern-lit garden is set in a 16th-century building and serves delicious Moroccan food; califavejer.com.
